

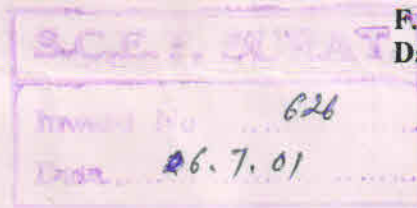

The admission will be made in accordance with Regulations notified by the AICTE vide GSR 476 (E) Dated 20.05.1994 based on the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgments dated 04.02.1993 with regard to WP (C) No.607 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishna JP and other etc. V/s State Government of Andhra Pradesh and others etc. and later judgments. No Management/institute/Trust or Society shall announce admissions directly under any circumstances. Any action contrary to this provision taken by the Institute will make it liable to be derecognised.

Further, in the event of infringement/contravention or non-compliance of the norms & standards prescribed by the AICTE during the last approved academic year, the council shall take further action to withdraw approval to this case for admission during subsequent academic year and the liability arising out of such withdrawal of approval will be solely that of Management/Trust/Society and/or Institutions.

The Council reserves the right to visit the Institution any time it may deem fit to note the progress.

SPECIFIC CONDITIONS TO BE FULFILLED BEFORE DECEMBER, 2001

a) Faculty (Full Time)

Existing Full time faculty (Professor : Nil, Asst. Professors : 2, Lecturers : 6) is inadequate in number and proportion for an intake of 40. The Institution must recruit a minimum additional faculty comprising of 3 Professors, 4 Asst Professors and 3 Lecturers having qualifications & Experience as per AICTE / COA norms, duly approved by University prior to commencement of academic session 2001-2002 and report compliance to the COA. No more than 25 % of the teaching load be given to Visiting faculty.

b) Visiting faculty

The Institution must invite Practicing Architects as Visiting faculty for a minimum of 50% of the teaching load for the subjects like, Architectural Design and Building Construction. Student - teacher ratio for Architectural Design studio shall be 10:1 and for Building Construction studio shall be 20:1.

c) Faculty of Architecture

In accordance with the decision of All India Board of Architectural Education of AICTE and Council of Architecture, South Gujarat University, Surat should create an Independent Faculty of Architecture before commencement of academic session 2002-2003 for proper development and growth of Architectural Education in this University.

d) Library

The Department of Architecture must have an independent Library of its own and must acquire atleast 200 titles (not Volumes) every year and subscribe to atleast 10 Indian and International Journals every year.

e) Computer Lab

The institution must create an exclusive Architectural Computer Lab having at least 40 Computers with requisite softwares latest by March 2002.

f) Construction Workshop

The Institution must create a yard where students are given first hand training on construction of building and its components.

g) Model Making Lab

The Institution must create an exclusive Model Making Lab.

h) QIP, Consultancy and Research

The institution must encourage its faculty to participate in Quality Improvement Programmes and also encourage them to undertake institutional consultancy and research work.

i) **Students Work**

Under the provisions of section 19 (1) of the Architects Act 1972, Council of Architecture experts shall witness the internal as well as University exam, particularly for Architectural design.

j) **Interaction with Alumni, Professional bodies & NASA**

The institution must encourage interaction of students with Alumni, professional bodies and NASA.

k) **Recruitment of faculty**

The Selection Committee for the Recruitment of teachers should have at least 1 representative of the Council of Architecture.

l) **Building**

Exclusive Lecture rooms are required for each of the 5 classes prior to commencement of academic session 2001-2002. The institution must have an independent building for School of Architecture as per AICTE/COA norms prior to commencement of academic session 2002-2003

m) **Lateral Admission**

The institution shall not permit lateral admission of students to B.Arch. degree course as it will violate the provisions of the Council of Architecture's Minimum Standards of Architectural Education Regulations, 1983 and All India Council for technical Education norms published in the Gazette of India Part II, Section 3(i) vide GSR No.320 dated 11th July, 1992.
