Dear Sir,

The Executive Committee of Council of Architecture (COA) at its 93rd meeting held on Wednesday, the 24th October, 2007 has decided that all those institutions which were inspected during the last three academic years i.e. 2006-2007, 2007-2008 & 2008-2009 and are due for inspection again during the academic session 2009-2010, may not be inspected. Further, the Executive Committee decided that these institutions be given one more year (i.e. for the academic session 2009-2010) recognition, on the basis of "Inspection/Extension of approval fee of Rs.35000/- and Form B & C", with their already existing intake.

2. Your institution was last inspected on 6th & 7th April 2006 for extension of approval to the existing M.Arch. The Inspection/Extension of approval fee of Rs.35,000/- has been received vide Receipt No.C07391 dated 27.10.2008. The Forms B & C has also been received. On the basis of the same, I am directed to state that the Executive Committee is pleased to accord **one more year recognition** to your institution as detailed below:

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6. Faculty and Visiting Faculty:

Faculty	Out of the total faculty required, a minimum of 1 Professor, 2 Asstt. Professors and 1 Lecturer shall be recruited duly approved by the University as per qualification and experience prescribed by COA. To start with, the School shall recruit at least 1 Professor and 1 Asst. Professor on full time basis from each of the specialisations to facilitate introduction of the course.
Visiting Faculty	The remaining faculty can be drawn from practice/Industry, however, 25% of the teaching load must be assigned to the visiting faculty.

7. *The Executive Committee also decided that no student should be admitted in a PG Course unless the required faculty is appointed by the institution.*

8.	Library	The Institution must acquire a minimum of 100 titles relevant to the proposed PG course and subsequently 50 titles be acquired annually and atleast five journals relevant to the course be subscribed to.
9.	Computer Studio	To start with, a minimum of 10 exclusive computers (to make up a Total of 20 in the second year of the course) and requisite software be acquired.
10.	Workshop and Laboratory	The Institution must create well equipped related workshop facilities and the existing facilities be enhanced from time to time.

11. The CoA will inspect your institution, before the expiration of the academic session 2009-2010, to ensure that your institution maintains the minimum standards as per the CoA's "Minimum Standards of Architectural Education Guidelines for Post-Graduate Programme 2006" which has already been circulated vide CoA's letter No.CA/5/Academic/PG & Ph.D Norms dated July 28, 2006 and also to grant of extension of approval or otherwise for the Academic Session 2010-2011 and/or beyond.

12. You are requested to initiate necessary remedial actions based on the inspection report and send your observations on the same, if any, for further consideration of the Executive Committee.

13. Admissions to the course shall be made as per the reservation policy of the respective State/Central Government.
